CHÂTEAU D'AIGUEVILLE

Between hillslopes, pine tree forests, olive trees and garrigues, the Château d'Aigueville vineyard have a privileged place in the heart of the Rhône valley. Certified organic, the vines are planted on clay-limestone soils covered with pebbles. The vineyard is full of biodiversity and the soils are alive.

Appellation: Côtes du Rhône Villages Massif d'Uchaux

Region: The Massif d'Uchaux is located at the north of Orange. It is an undulating Landscape going from 100 to 250 m from the sea level.

Soils: Red clays and sandstone covered with pebbles

Grape varieties : 60 % Grenache, 40 % Syrah

Average age of vines: 40 years old

Aging: 40 % barrels, 60 % concrete vats

Operating temperature: 14-16°C

Ageing potential: 20 years

Dégustation

Color: Deep red

Nose: Black fruits (blueberry, blackberry), garrigues (thyme, rosemary)

Mouth: Generosity and fineness. Aromas of strawberry, spices and garrigues. There is a delicate saline touch at the end of mouth.

This wine will perfectly match with dishes containing lamb, game and red meat grilled.
